### Visiting University of Turku Finland


In April this year Drs Scott and Maarit Harden visited University of Turku in Finland to review their successful pilot program for teaching CBT to families of primary age children. Professor Andre Sourander invited us to visit with their research team and have lunch with them. It was a time of sharing ideas and encouraging the future development of online options in providing training and cognitive behaviour therapy. While there, Dr Scott Harden gave a lecture on the current specialist situation in Queensland Australia.

## TIPS and TRICKS for FAMILIES DEALING with ANXIETY

The child and adolescent psychiatrists at Child Psychiatry Brisbane have limited availability for new referrals. Our team frequently communicates with parents on multiple waiting lists for specialized care access. To support these families, Associate Professor Scott Harden and Dr Maarit Harden developed an innovative course to assist families in working together in managing anxiety. Many await formal diagnoses, needing specialists to identify ADHD, Autism, or Anxiety as primary or combined issues. This course addresses this group, offering fundamental insights useful across presentations, as anxiety often co-occurs. It equips families with skills while awaiting specialist appointments for their child.


